

## **EURYTHMY TEACHER Job Description**

- 1. Role of the Eurythmy teacher is:
- to have a secure working understanding of child development and the ethos and pedagogy underpinning practice in a Steiner school;
- to hold overall responsibility for each eurythmy group in your care;
- to work as part of a team, sharing responsibility for the well-being of the children in the school;
- to create a harmonious and well disciplined environment in which the pupils can participate fully in eurythmy
- to support the School's ethos, principles and objectives
- 2. Main responsibilities of the Eurythmy teacher include:
- to work with creative discipline in a relevant way;
- to liaise with teaching and admin. colleagues, learning support staff, and, where available, appropriate therapists and educational specialists
- 3. General responsibilities of the Eurythmy teacher include:
- to care for and maintain the eurythmy teaching space;
- to cover for colleagues when necessary and reasonable;
- to attend meetings, festivals and week-end events where appropriate;
- to carry out agreed additional responsibilities and duties as requested by the Management Group;
- 4. Additional responsibilities of Eurythmy teacher include:
- to record each child's progress and use such data to support lesson plans;
- to support colleagues in the context of the Teachers' Meeting;

- to work with the accompanist as required and to give advice and training if necessary;
- to adhere to school procedures and relevant statutory regulations, with particular reference to the Safeguarding Policy;
- to adhere to the Health and Safety Policies of the school;
- 6. Responsibilities for Quality Development and Care of the eurythmy teacher include:
- to participate in the Staff Appraisal process;
- to undertake appropriate training and further study, as necessary
